Reporting Unemployment Fraud

1. Contact your Human Resources Staff to report the incident to you employer
2. Contact Washington State Employment Security Department:
<https://esd.wa.gov/unemployment/unemployment-benefits-fraud>
 - a. You will need the following information:
 - i. Your full name
 - ii. Last 4 numbers of your Social Security number (never put your full SSN in an email)
 - iii. Your address
 - iv. Your date of birth
 - v. Brief description of how you found an imposter-fraud claim was filed using your information
 - vi. Please let them know: If an imposter-fraud claim was filed using your information, do you give them permission to deny and cancel it?
3. File an on-line police report – Federal Way residents can file here:

4. Report to the three major credit bureaus
 - a. Request your free credit reports from: Equifax, Experian, and TransUnion at www.annualcreditreport.com or call 1-877-322-8228
 - b. Place an alert with one of the credit bureaus. That credit bureau will notify the other two credit bureaus.
 - i. Experian: 1-888-397-3742
 - ii. Trans Union: 1-800-680-7289
 - iii. Equifax: 1-888-766-0008
 - c. Consider a Credit Freeze
