Frequently Asked Questions regarding FW Youth Safety Academy

Q. Do I have to attend both days of class in order to participate?

A. Yes, the program is designed as a two day Academy in which the days build on each other. Please only submit an application if you can attend both days.

Q. How much does the FW Youth Academy Cost?

A. NOTHING! It is completely free!

Q. Do I need to provide transportation to the academy both days?

A. Yes, you will need to provide your own transportation to the academy on both days.

Q. Should I bring a lunch?

A. No, lunch will be provided each day for you along with snacks and water bottles.

Q. What should I wear to class?

A. Wear something casual and comfortable. You will be doing hands on activities both days so please dress accordingly. No hats.

Q. Do I have to have experience or interest in Law Enforcement/Fire Service to be a good candidate?

A. No, a student does not need to be part of a criminal justice program or planning to have a career in these fields. The primary objective is to have youth participate who are capable of leadership and have an interest in what Federal Way Police Department and South King Fire and Rescue do.
