

## **Federal Way Police Department VOLUNTEER POSITION DESCRIPTION**

**POSITION:**           **ECAT VOLUNTEER**

**PURPOSE:**        To assist with the reduction of auto theft by staffing the ECAT (Empty Car for Auto Theft Reduction) Program.

**DUTIES:**           Select locations for ECAT vehicles.

Position marked police vehicles as visible deterrents.

Deploy vehicles, as requested, to support traffic emphasis activities, crime prevention projects, or similar situations where the ECAT vehicle would act as a deterrent.

Maintain files and/or records associated with the above duties.

**REQUIREMENTS:** Ability to learn and perform the above duties.

Ability to work with sensitive information and maintain strict confidentiality.

Possess a valid Washington State Drivers License, and a good driving record.

Possess good judgment in the use of vehicles and equipment.

Ability to work with minimal supervision.

**COMMITMENT  
REQUIRED:**

One shift per week (approximately 2 hours) generally in early morning or late afternoon. Time is flexible to accommodate volunteer availability.

**COMMENTS:**

A criminal record check and polygraph examination will be performed for all volunteers.

Volunteers will be under the supervision of a Patrol Lieutenant.
